## Basic Requirements

- ✦ Age: between 19 and 40 years old.
- ✦ To have contact with one of the missionaries responsible for the program
- ✦ To have emotional stability, maturity and be in a state of good health
- ✦ To be responsible in your commitments, open and capable of interacting with people of other cultures
- ✦ To desire to encounter and serve Christ who is present in every human being, and especially in the migrant.

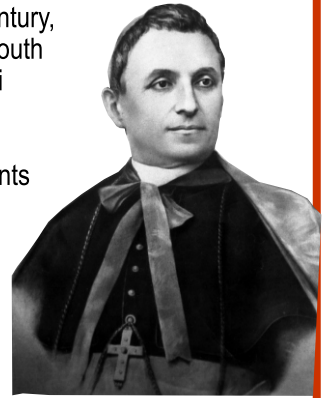

## The Scalabrinian Missionaries are present in 33 countries on 5 continents

- ✦ We provide assistance to migrants and deportees.
- ✦ We live in solidarity with the displaced.
- ✦ We work to raise awareness about the migration phenomenon with magazines, TV, radio programs, etc.
- ✦ We advise episcopal conferences and governments in the field of migration studies through our research, educational and pastoral centers.
- ✦ We provide hospitality for the migrants & deportees who lack a safe place to stay in their journey, providing food, medical social assistance, legal as well as job counseling.
- ✦ We assist the internal migrants.
- ✦ We promote human rights for the migrants.

## BLESSED JOHN BAPTIST SCALABRINI 1839-1905

Driven by the subhuman condition of migrants at the end of the nineteenth century, who were forced to migrate towards South and North America. Blessed Scalabrini called the attention to the Church, governments, and the public of the complexity and hardships of the migrants experience. He worked tirelessly to improve the plight of migrants. In 1887 he founded the Congregation of Scalabrinian Missionaries of St. Charles Borromeo with the firm purpose of serving the migrants spiritual and material needs.
